This Indenture made the 24th day of May
in the year of Our Lord One Thousand eight
Hundred and fifty nine between Georgiana A.
Blight of the County of Fauquier in the State of
Virginia of the first part, and Wm W Carter
of the said County and State of or said of the
other part, witnesseth, That the said Georgiana
A. Blight for and in consideration of the
sum of one dollar to her in hand paid by the
said Wm W Carter at and before the sealing and
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged. She the said —
Georgiana A Blight has bargained and sold
and by these presents doth bargain and sell
unto the said Wm W Carter his heirs and assigns
a certain lot or parcel of land lying in the
County of Fauquier in the state of Virginia
and bounded as follows, Beginning at (1) a
stone in a line of said Carter and running S 22 $\frac{1}{4}$ E.
43 $\frac{7}{10}$ poles to (2) a stone corner to said Carter &
Blight thence with carters line N 82 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 30 $\frac{9}{10}$
poles to (3) a stone, thence N. 22 E. 38 $\frac{9}{10}$ poles to the
beginning. Containing three acres two rods &
Twenty three perches be the same more or less,
together with all and singular the appertaining
thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining
and all the Estate right and title and interest
whatsoever of her the said Georgiana A Blight
and her heirs in law Equity or otherwise of in
and to the same — To have and to hold the same
lot or parcel of land and the appurtenances —
unto the said Wm W Carter and to his heirs and
assigns forever. And, the said Georgiana

At Bleight doth for herself her heirs Executors
Administrators or assigns Covenant and agree
by these presents that She will warrant and
forever defend the right and title to the said
lot or parcel of land and its appertenances -
unto the Said Mr. Mcarter and his heirs and
assigns forever - against the claims of all
and every other person or persons whom-
soever. In Testimony whereof the said
